BAGNI MISTERIOSI BATHING ESTABLISHMENTREGULATION CODE 2022



The Regulation posted inside the sports facility, governs its use. It is considered to be read and unconditionally accepted in all its parts by all users in possession of an entrance ticket.

The entrance ticket is a non-transferable receipt and it expires upon leaving the site. Users must show their ticket to the staff members at the entrance and/or whenever required. If you cannot provide evidence of your ticket, you will have to pay for another one. You are not allowed to go out and re-enter the site with the same ticket. Season tickets and/or carnets are multiple, personal, non-transferable admission tickets, under penalty of revocation of their validity.

Upon request by the staff, you must provide evidence of your subscription and leave it at the main reception.

During opening hours, minors under the age of 16 may enter the swimming pool only if they are accompanied by a parent or an adult over 18, responsible for them. They can be asked their Identity Card.

The Management, in its sole discretion, for circumstances of force majeure and in case of bad weather, reserves the right to:

- · Close the ticket office and deny entrance to the pool to any individual.
- · Close the site in exceptional circumstances. All users might be required to leave the site, if necessary.
- · Proceed in exceptional circumstances to close the pool, even temporarily, or temporarily or partially suspend bathing.
- In these cases, tickets cannot be refunded.

The Management employs security Staff for the sports facility and therefore reserves the right to deny access or expel:

- People disturbing public order and morals with an inappropriate behaviour such as shouting, dangerous games, or any other behaviour causing damage to the good performance of the activities.
- · People not complying with current regulations to counter and contain the spread of the Covid-19 virus.
- People affected by contagious illnesses, lesions or open wounds. The Management is authorised to ask for the medical certificate attesting the fitness to enter the swimming pool.

Tickets cannot be refunded to those who have been asked to leave the site for the reasons above mentioned.

Staff is not in charge of:

- · Valuables, money or any other belongings which might be found in the lockers and changing rooms, even if locked.
- · Supervising nor collecting or keeping any valuables or equipment.
- · Any damage to personal belongings such as, by way of example, bathing suits, swimming trunks, sunglasses, beach robe, slippers, etc.
- · In case of bad weather, tickets cannot be refunded nor rescheduled for a later date.
- · In case of not opening, only tickets sold online will be refunded.

Changing rooms:

Pool users are required to change in the changing rooms, for the time strictly needed, and make sure not to leave any belongings unattended. Personal belongings are to be put in the lockers subject to availability. The lockers are provided with a lock, therefore the use of padlocks is recommended.

When cleaning out the locker, individuals are required to make sure it is completely empty. After closing time, the Staff is authorised to check all lockers for any neglected belongings.

Baby pool:

In the baby pool is highly recommended to use non-slip shoes (ask to the staff)

Users are required to:

- Follow the instructions given by the Staff.
- · Wear a swimsuit; Wear a swimming cap; Wear appropriate and waterproof footwear by the pool.
- Take a shower before entering the pool.
- · Children under 3 years of age are required to wear retentive swimsuits.
- Those who are physiologically incontinent, are required to wear suitable swimsuits.
- · Children under 8 years of age need to be accompanied to the changing rooms.
- Swim within the swimming lanes to avoid disturbing other swimmers.
- Refer to the Staff responsible for the area before starting any activity.
- · Use the bins available onsite for any litter. Any rules on the bins regarding the type of waste must be respected.

It is forbidden to:

- · Bring any harmful objects (i.e. objects made of glass) which might harm individuals or damage the facility.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Leave kids alone in all areas; Let dogs or any other pets in, even if kept on a leash.
- Smoke, according to the law 03/2003 and any changes to the current legislation on the matter, in force at the time of reading this regulation. Smoking is only allowed in the smoking areas.
- Wear glasses, sunglasses, or swimming goggles, if not unbreakable in water.
- · Remove the electronic bracelet before leaving the site.
- Bring radios or any other sound device.
- · Chase each another, push each other in the pool or do anything which might bring danger to themselves and/or others.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ $\;$ Run by the pool; Climb trees and facilities; Pick up flowers and enter the flower beds.
- Occupy areas assigned for walking by the pool; Swim near and under the platform for any reason.
- Occupy the lifeguards' area; Occupy the lanes booked for activities organized by the Management.
- Bring food and beverages from outside; Eat food and/or drink inside the pool, by the pool, on the steps and in the changing rooms.
- · Take both indoor and outdoor showers without a swimsuit or remove the swimsuit in an open public space.
- Organize courses, whether individual or collective, even if they are free.

It is also forbidden to:

- Dive with a run-up, dive backwards, with a flip/somersault or in any other dangerous manner; Dive from the platform; Swim underwater.
- Play with a ball in the pool, by the pool or in every other area; Use any type of fishing equipment including fins, swimming masks and snorkels or any other blunt, bulky or dangerous object, such as swimming boards.
- Take pictures or films; Distribute or display brochures/posters or any advertising material.
- Being topless.
- Bring and use inside the sports facility and the pool inflatable mattresses and boats, lifebelts, ect.
- Enter the pool area or the steps with a stroller/pushchair.

The equipment, the materials, and every game for underage children must be used respectfully and carefully under the strict supervision of the parent or the adult in charge according to the rules shown or given by the Staff. The parent or the adult in charge is the only responsible for any damage caused by the underage to himself, to third parties or to equipment, materials and games. The Management and the Staff in no case assume an obligation to supervise the behaviour of minors and are therefore exempt from any liability.

Users are required to comply strictly with these provisions and those which may be provided by the Staff.

The areas are under video surveillance.
